As a registered charity the Aberdeen and District Beekeepers' Association can reclaim tax on gifts by UK taxpayers made to the Association (including annual membership subscriptions) where the taxpayer has completed a Gift Aid declaration. The taxpayer incurs no additional cost when making a Gift Aid declaration. The supplemental income from Gift Aid is an important source of revenue for the Association.
